UPCOMING EVENTS:

A few reminders for school days:

- Allergen-Aware: we have students with life-threatening allergies to nuts – please review the attached notice. *Further information will be sent home with specific classes as needed. Thank you for your help in ensuring a safe environment for all students.*
- **Traffic and Parking**: We do not have any assigned parking areas. Parents and caregivers who are picking up children must follow all the rules of the road, including parking rules. So please do not park on yellow lines, or on a crosswalk, or on the corner of an intersection. SAFETY FIRST!!! If a vehicle is blocking a crosswalk, then a child will not be able to see oncoming traffic and it will be very dangerous for him/her.
- The United Church parking lot is a private lot for their parishioners and events only. Please do not park there at any time.
- For those parents crossing the street with their children, please set a good example and use the marked crosswalks.
- Please help your child to arrive on time. Grade 6,7,8 students enter the school at 8:40am. Grades K to 5 line up at the 8:50am bell.
